AGENDA 1: APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MINUTES: .

The action taken report was displayed, and discussions pertaining to that were carried out:


AGENDA 8: STUDENT RELATED MATTERS

9. Need for the support of the physical education teacher to help in stock checking and to accompany them for sports competitions: approval for the same was given by the

works out a preliminary plan and presents it to the principal.

11. Questions on how to proceed with associated activities by MABP were addressed, for which Ms. Alphonsa and Dr. Rashmi J. Bhat urged that propositions may be put forth by third parties and taken forward only when they propose via proper channel. In addition to this, they also advised student council members to voice out or process their grievances formally.

12. On their query about proceeding with the intercollegiate festival, it was suggested to them to work out a plan and come up with the same, and that they could also approach ISHA and HA companies for sponsorship. Dr. Anita Reddy suggested approaching reputed organisations such as TATA for sponsorship. The tentative timeline for the

same is June/July 2024.

13. Queries about the number of CCA hours were resolved: 3 hours of CCA are allotted per month. In response to their concern about students not attending CCA hour, Dr. Anita Reddy suggested house leaders be held accountable and give attendance to only those who are strictly present. 

Diploma in education of the hearing impaired: To date, in the PG Diploma in 1987 and 1988, 12 have passed out and in the DEd(HI) conducted by AYJNISHD, 280 have passed out. Over 80% are employed in special schools.

In the B.ASLP and M.ASLP, MSc(Audiology) MSc(Speech Language Pathology, the majority are employed and working. A large segment has gone abroad. The impact may be though in terms of second generation persons (two), fourteen siblings/cousins, sometimes three siblings joining the course besides referral by past students. We consider this as a testimony to our work. Employment offers of 2023 are attached.

The Institute has been accredited by NAAC. It has improved its grade from B in the first cycle at 2017 to B+ in the second cycle in 2023. Student numbers have reached pre COVID times since 2023.

Feedback from the stakeholders be they persons for assessment or therapy is taken regularly and action taken if there are suggestions. Student feedback is good, with the majority rating the teaching and facilities as good. The Google summary sheet is attached.





Impact of the Institute

Dr. S. R. Chandrasekhar Institute of Speech and Hearing has been sustained by the efforts of trustees and donors for 46 years, this is the 47th year. We have received grants from Tech Mahindra and SBI Foundation. Diploma in education of the hearing impaired: To date, in the PG Diploma in 1987 and 1988, 12 have passed out and in the DEd(HI) conducted by AYJNISHD, 280 have passed out. Over 80% are employed in special schools.

In the B.ASLP and M.ASLP, MSc(Audiology) MSc(Speech Language Pathology, the majority are employed and working. A large segment has gone abroad. The impact may be though in terms of second generation persons (two), fourteen siblings/cousins, sometimes three siblings joining the course besides referral by past students. We consider this as a testimony to our work. Employment offers of 2023 are attached.

The Institute has been accredited by NAAC. It has improved its grade from B in the first cycle at 2017 to B+ in the second cycle in 2023. Student numbers have reached pre COVID times since 2023.

3. Dr. Shakila Naidu appointed as Professor in Practice has consented to also provide student counseling, and free counseling sessions by Parivarthan Counselling Centre, Indiranagar have been announced.

The Convenor then reported on the activities of the last 6 months.

Information was provided about the status of introduction of new UG courses; BSc in Rehab Science and BSc Psychology. Rehab Science course has to be approved by RCI for which online process will begin in May 2024. The report included Accreditation status, PG Admissions, Results of UG and PG, Awards and Recognitions obtained by faculty, participation of faculty in conferences, publications, paper presentations, faculty Upskilling, in house training and Faculty Development Programmes. She also highlighted the Student Enrichment programmes, Student participation in (a) conferences, (b) the fellowship programs, (c) field visits, (d) talks from experts in field other than Speech and Hearing (BBC – Beyond Books and College) were listed out. Update on Research unit, infrastructure, staff position, NSS activities and awareness activities were mentioned. Finally Comparison of clinical statistics with previous report period was done, including data from SBI Grant activities and Satellite Centre at Pavagada.

IQAC Co-ordinator Ms. Sneha Mareen Varghese then updated the gathering on IQAC initiatives undertaken during the last 6 months. Student representative also presented the activities taken by students during the same period.

Feedback from stakeholders was presented and action taken/to be taken on them. Future plans were discussed, and few requests like Colleges asking for credits, internship and field work opportunities, protocol for the internship offered to ENT PGs and psychology students etc were submitted for needed opinion by GCM. Dr. Ashok suggested for ENT PGs we can follow the same pattern as our Internship and for Psychology course it has to be equated to credit and have to be approved by the BOS.

Further, Student representative mentioned that the involvement of students in cultural, sports and any activities including recreational activities have become very less after the COVID. Parent representative mentioned about issues of result not published on time, getting late information from university etc. The Chairperson informed the after trifurcation of the University, issues have become more.

Mention was made of the PG results pending of the 2021 batch. She explained that, as per RCI criteria, UG and PG syllabus requires 50% minimum pass separately in IA, Theory and VIVA marks and currently this issue has been pending with the UUCMS. For this Dr. Ashok and Dr. Prathibha Karanth suggested to speak to Registrar Evaluation for solution and the same has to be added in the student transcript.

Regarding shortage of attendance by students due to health issues, Dr. Maiya suggested about providing Health Insurance for the students and compulsory annual health checkup too. Dr. Karanth suggested that Blood donation camp and Annual Health checkup can be combined on same day.

Convenor then requested members for suggestion as to how to handle requests for credits, internship from other colleges etc for which Dr. Ashok opined that it can be equated to number of credits approved by Board of Studies and structured accordingly.

Dr. Prathibha Karanth and Dr. Ashok suggested the Digitalization of clinical data has to be given top priority as it is difficult to carry out studies using data mining approach. We keep only physical records from last 5 years.

Dr. Yamini and Dr. Maiya were interested to know about Job Mela and scope of employment after speech and Hearing course to which Convenor opined that around 10 companies attended the job mela and it was a successful event.

Dr. Ashok enquired about HR appointment, to which Mr. Suresh Babu answered that it is happening shortly. Student representative raised issue on canteen food not up to the mark. Governing Council members suggested that one staff should occasionally taste the food for quality control.

Some suggestions for Value Added Course were given by Dr. Ashok and Dr. Maiya like Self Defense course, first aid programme from St. Johns Medical College and Red Cross etc, The poor attendance issue was deemed serious by the members and Chairperson suggested that LMS to be integrated to the college office within the next 6 months.

Dr. Ashok also mentioned that Alumni association contribution would be in terms of donation of books to library, scholarship for poor student's education, Freeship etc.

Chairperson suggested to include Dr. Molly Joy, Principal Montfort College, in place of Brother Victor Raj as Governing Council Member.

The Chairperson and members appreciated the overall improvement seen in the activities over the last six months.

The meeting ended with thanks to the chair by Secretary, Mr. Suresh Babu.
