

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

- 2. The two institutions recognize that the implementation of any agreed upon activity will depend on the interests and expertise of the individuals involved and the availability of financial resources. space and other resources. Accordingly, the implementation of any exchange and cooperation based on this MOU shall be separately negotiated and determined between the two institutions.
- 3. This MOU will become effective from the date of signing by both institutions. The agreement will remain in effect for three years, and may be renewed or amended by mutual agreements of the institutions. The institutions agree to periodically review the activities undertaken and progress made and to consult each other concerning amendments, renewal or termination of this MOU. 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

We, at, Bowring and Lady Curzon hospital, Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical college and Research Institute, Bengaluru do not have necessary Rehabilitative services required for children post cochlear implantation. Therefore, we have entered into an MOU with SAST recognized **Dr. S.R. Chandrasekhar Institute Speech and Hearing**, for rehabilitative services required for children operated at Bowring and Lady Curzon hospital, Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical college and Research Institute. Rehabilitation services will include Intraoperative measurements, Switch-on, Mapping and Auditory Verbal Therapy (AVT) for a period of one year from the date of Switch-on. We Understand that the Cochlear Implant treatment requires a multi-modality approach i.e. Assessment, Surgery and Rehabilitation therapy.

We at Bowring and Lady Curzon hospital, Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical college and Research Institute, are having only surgical facility and we do not have the other facility for further treatment i.e., AV therapy and rehabilitation.

Therefore, we have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with **Dr S.R. Chandrasekhar Institute of speech and Hearing** (AV therapy centre) who are having the facility for treatment of auditory Verbal Therapy which is also empanelled under the state Cochlear Implant Scheme.

- A) We, the management of Bowring and Lady Curzon hospital, Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical College and Research Institute, undertake the following responsibilities.
  - Shall carry-out the required investigations at the rates fixed by the SAST.
  - II. Shall refund the investigation charges so once collected, the patient becomes a beneficiary under any of the schemes of SAST.
  - III. All the treating Doctors will jointly arrive at the line of treatment required to ensure total treatment of the beneficiary.

- VII. Shall refer the patient to the AVT centre on our own cost and ensure the patient is not liable to pay any amount towards transportation (to and fro), food, stay and treatment.

### WHEREAS,

MAHE provides education, healthcare and conducts research in the field of Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Nursing, Allied Health, Life Sciences, Public Health, Virology and Regenerative Medicine, Engineering, Sciences, Hotel Management, Architecture, Management, Information Science, Atomic & Molecular Physics, Design, Commerce, Culinary Arts, Allied Hospitality Studies, Applied Sciences, Natural Sciences, Media & Communication, Geopolitics & International Relations, European Studies, Humanities, Library and Information Science streams

### AND WHEREAS,

A. At BNGRC, the primary mandate is to promote and undertake research in the area of Speech Language Pathology, Audiology, Swallowing disorders, Neuro-communicative disorders and Processes.

- B. BNGRC is a recognized centre of MAHE for conducting the PhD programme.
- C. BNGRC offers research programmes leading to PhD degree for those who have a Master's degree in Speech Language Pathology, Audiology, Hearing Sciences and related fields Pscyhology: Linguistics Special Education (HI; MR; ASD; LD).
- D. MAHE will recognize the regular PhD programme offered at BNGRC and award PhD Degrees to successful candidates in accordance with the procedures set out in this memorandum of understanding.

For and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained hereinafter, the sufficiency and adequacy is hereby acknowledged by both the Parties, intending to be legally bound, MAHE and BNGRC agree as follows:

- 1) The PhD degree certificate to be issued by MAHE shall not indicate the subject or specialty. The title of the thesis shall be indicated in such certificate.
- 2) Each of the PhD candidates from BNGRC registering at MAHE will pay fees to MAHE as prescribed by MAHE.
- 3) The research supervisor/s for the students admitted to the PhD programme will be the PhD guides approved by MAHE, identified by the Director, BNGRC and intimated to MAHE when the candidates register for the degree.

The PhD candidates of BNGRC have to make a presentation of the PhD protocol before PhD Committee of MAHE at no cost to MAHE. Alternatively, if the presentation is to

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be done at BNGRC, a representative of MAHE must be present there, whose TA and DA must be borne by BNGRC.

- 5) Approved guide of MAHE shall have
  - a) Not more than eight PhD candidates under his/her guideship at any given time (including candidates registered in other Universities) for the purpose of guidance of their thesis as a Chief Supervisor and;
  - b) Not more than two students per academic year.
- 6) After completion of the minimum prescribed term, BNGRC will, submit a list of examiners, if requested by MAHE for evaluation of the thesis. However, MAHE may send the thesis to any examiner whom MAHE feels best as per the situation and expertise. This is followed by the submission of the synopsis and the thesis, thereafter. The Registrar Evaluation of MAHE shall confidentially deal with all these matters as follows and will award the PhD degree.
- 7) The presentation (defense) of the thesis has to be made either at MAHE or at a PhD centre where a representative of MAHE has to be present whose TA/DA must be borne by the MAHE recognized PhD Centre. The travel cost and remuneration payable to examiners will have to be met by the PhD Centre as per the prescribed norms by MAHE.
- 8) BNGRC will not request any grant from the MAHE for conducting and administering the PhD programme. Accordingly, MAHE will not require BNGRC to contribute financially except those that have been specifically been referred to earlier in this MOU.
- 9) MAHE and / or its affiliates and / or its associates shall hold all the Confidential Information and / or portion thereof in strict confidence, as a trustee thereof, without disclosing the same to any unauthorized persons or entity or third party (ies), whatsoever and howsoever, save and except as provided under this MoV.

10) The PhD candidates will present "actual" and not "coded" scientific work carried out. The suggestion, Ideas, modifications, correction and criticisms for the proper project/thesis proposal will be provided by the MAHE Committee when the BNGRC's

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candidates present. BNGRC is encouraged to have a co-guide from MAHE who has expertise in the field of the candidate's research.

- 11) MAHE will keep a record of PhD protocol, progress reports, synopsis, and thesis copies of PhD candidates.
- 12) If presentations in conferences, workshops, symposia or publications include the work or part of the work of candidates' thesis, the candidates' co guide/experts should be duly acknowledged as co-authors and affiliation of the PhD candidate should read as Research Scholar, Manipal Academy of Higher Education.
- 13) MAHE will not claim any part of the IPR resulting from this collaboration if the invention originates from the work done at BNGRC.
- 14) Both parties will use their best efforts to settle all matters of dispute amicably. All disputes and differences of any kind related to the study, which cannot be solved amicably by the parties, shall be referred to arbitration. The arbitration proceedings are carried out in accordance to laws encompassed under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996.

WHEREAS, DR. S. R. CHANDRASEKHAR INSTITUTE OF SPEECH AND HEARING, BENGALURU has the facilities to provide clinical services in the field of speech and hearing in the country, and

WHEREAS, the cochlear implantation program requires a multi specialty approach i.e., Assessment, Surgery, and Rehabilitation services,

WHEREAS, RBSK-SAST Cochlear Implant (CI) program has identified IGICH as a network hospital for surgery; and DR. S. R. CHANDRASEKHAR INSTITUTE OF SPEECH AND HEARING, BENGALURU as audiological evaluation, mapping and rehabilitation centre, with the objective of providing cochlear implants to eligible clients identified through the SAST-RBSK CI program, and

WHEREAS, to ensure the smooth functioning of the RBSK-SAST cochlear implant program, IGICH and DR. S. R. CHANDRASEKHAR INSTITUTE OF SPEECH AND HEARING, BENGALURU have arrived at an understanding and have resolved to reduce into writing the broad outlines thereof, NOW THEREFORE, this Memorandum of Understanding witnesseth as under:

Indira Gandhi Institute of Child Health (primary hospital) is having only surgical facility and does not have the other facilities for treatment i.e., rehabilitation services (switch-on, mapping, and auditory verbal therapy - AVT).

Therefore, IGICH, Bengaluru (surgery centre) has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with DR. S. R. CHANDRASEKHAR INSTITUTE OF SPEECH AND HEARING, BENGALURU, (rehabilitation centre) who are having the facilities, which are empanelled under the scheme of Suvarna Arogya Suraksha Trust (SAST).

A) The management of IGICH hospital undertake the following responsibilities

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- i) shall carry-out the required investigations at the rates fixed by the RBSK-SAST CI program.

- iii) Cochlear Implant Surgeon and the Audiologist who gives the report will jointly arrive at the line of treatment required to ensure total treatment of the beneficiary.
- iv) shall upload the preauths for all the modes of treatment (Surgery Cochlear Implantation)
- v) once the treatment is completed, collect all the necessary documents required for claim submission and all claims will be submitted only by IGICH.
- vi) shall abide by the other conditions of MoU signed under the schemes of RBSK-SAST CI program.
- vii) shall refer the patient to DR. S. R. CHANDRASEKHAR INSTITUTE OF SPEECH AND HEARING, BENGALURU and ensure that the patient is refunded by IGICH, the prescribed charges towards transportation (to and fro), food, stay and treatment as per RBSK-SAST CI guidelines. The refund will be based on the attendance certificate issued by DR. S. R. CHANDRASEKHAR INSTITUTE OF SPEECH AND HEARING, BENGALURU.
- viii) shall collect all the necessary documents required for claim submission and all claims will be submitted only by IGICH.
- ix) Payment towards rehabilitation services (switch-on, mapping, and AVT) will be made to DR. S. R. CHANDRASEKHAR INSTITUTE OF SPEECH AND HEARING, BENGALURU at regular intervals as per RBSK-SAST CI guidelines.
- B) The management of DR. S. R. CHANDRASEKHAR INSTITUTE OF SPEECH AND HEARING, BENGALURU, undertake the following responsibilities:

i) shall provide rehabilitation services (switch-on, mapping, and AVT) to the beneficiary referred by IGICH.

- v) shall send attendance certificate to IGICH. Based on this, the IGICH will release payment for food, travel and wage loss to the beneficiary, as outlined in the RBSK-SAST CI guidelines.
- vi) in case of a death in the therapy centre, the transportation shall be borne by the primary hospital for shifting of patient's body from hospital to the patient's native.
- C) Switch-on, Mapping, and therapy will begin at DR. S. R. CHANDRASEKHAR INSTITUTE OF SPEECH AND HEARING, BENGALURU, have rehabilitation facilities (switch-on, mapping, and AVT), qualified and experienced professionals required for post cochlear implant management and we agree to take the responsibility of rehabilitation services for cochlear implantees operated at IGICH Hospital for further switch-on, Mapping, and AVT at our centre for a period of one year. The centre agrees to maintain progress report of every child attending Mapping and AVT for a period of one year. This will be shared with IGICH hospital to further coordinate with SAST.





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
