National and International days, events, festivals celebrated:

1. Over 100 women at the Dr.SRCISH stepped away from their work desks and classrooms to commemorate and celebrate International Women's day on 8-03-2018. On this day we celebrated the spirit of womanhood- everyone was encouraged to pause, re-evaluate and remember the way women inspire us, and how they deserve to be honorary, loved, and admired not only on Women's day but throughout the year. On this occasion, the Women Empowerment Committee took charge of the event. The day was kick started with a video that brought in a different perspective and raised questions as to "Celebrate or Uncelebrate" the event. The highlight of the event was a survey that was conducted around the institute where the majority agreed that the need for celebration was unarguable. Fun games such as "tie those scarves right", "what's in that bag" and "a scavenger hunt" and musical competitions that included the men as well were thoroughly enjoyed by the audience which included staff and students. Prizes were distributed for the same. A musical challenge was thrown in for each class to express their way of celebrating girl power which was judged by the staff. The hour-long event ended with the audience inspired to beat the patriarchy and preconceived notions and dogmas prevalent in a male-dominated society.

2. World Hearing Day:

A. On the occasion of World Hearing Day on 3rd March 2019, the Department of Hearing Studies conducted several activities on the theme proposed by World Health Organization, "Check Your Hearing". The aims were to "Raise awareness on hearing loss and care" and "Regular hearing Checks". This programme was supported by WHO by awarding a fund of 750 US Dollars under the World Hearing Day, 2019 Small Grants Scheme. The institute was one among the 16 selected applicants from a total of 101 applications across the Globe. Activity began with a free hearing screening camp for a week until 8th March 2019 at Institute.

B. Awareness programme in rural and urban areas on the hazardous effect of recreation activities like listening to loud music were carried out. The target audience in the **urban** areas were college students and in the rural area were the people who attended the free hearing screening at Pavagada.

C. Awareness programme to college students titled **"Dangerous deciBels"** was conducted by Mr. Suman N Assistant Professor, Department of Hearing Studies at St. Anne's College and Jyothi Nivas College, Bangalore focusing on the hazardous effects of recreational hearing loss, it included the use of a mannequin developed by the Institute, called the Karna with a microphone in its ear canal connected to a sound level meter that measures the output of an earphone plugged to the personal music system. A questionnaire was given to raise awareness and to see the effectiveness of the programme conducted. Mr.Nithin K Dhaman Clinical Supervisor coordinated with a



similar activity focusing on the **rural** population at a hearing screening camp at Pavagada.

D. "Antharala-Discover the new you": An awareness programme was carried out at Orion East Shopping Mall, Bangalore by the way of a flash mob that attracted more than 1000 people. At the end of the performance, Ms. Deena Priya Asst. Prof, Dept of Hearing Studies addressed the gathering about the signs and symptoms of hearing loss and the importance of hearing testing. This was well received by the public and the mall authorities requested a second round of performances.

E. A walkathon titled "Vidhyuth" in support of raising awareness on safer listening levels was organized by Dr.SRCISH sponsored by the parents association of Deaf children Mysore. Around 50-60 participants including the Principal, the Vice Principal, faculty members, and students of Dr.SRCISH took part in the walkathon. The walkathon began at 8 am from Jalvayuvihar signal, Kammanahalli wound its way through Kammanahalli Main Road, and terminated at Dr.SRCISH. During the course, students distributed pamphlets to the shops and general public, containing tips on safer listening levels and the hazardous effects of recreational hearing loss.

3. World voice day:

A. Press meet at Press Club Bangalore, was held on April 9, 2018. Dr. Madhuri Gore, Principal spoke about the Institute and the services provided. Dr. B S Premalatha, HOD also spoke about the Department of Speech Language Studies, and shared information regarding the different cases seen and services offered. Dr. Anita Reddy, Associate Professor elaborated on the voice clinic, the free voice camp which was to be held at the Institute from 9th -13th April, 2018. She also shared information on awareness regarding world voice day emphasizing the importance of preservation of voice for professional voice users. An awareness program was conducted by distributing pamphlets for the above-mentioned free voice camp. The pamphlets were distributed in various Kannada and English newspapers. Many patients visited the Institute to get their voices evaluated. This awareness encouraged other different speech and language disordered to approach Dr.SRCISH for their respective assessments.

B. The Department of Speech and Language Studies invited Dr. Shantanu Tandon M.S., DLO, DNB, is currently working as a Consultant ENT Surgeon & Laryngology Specialist at Sakra World Hospital, Bangalore, as a guest speaker on the occasion of "World Voice Day" which was held on April 16th, 2018. He delivered an excellent lecture on "Professional Voice Care from an ENT perspective". His presentation included interesting videos; it gave the students and staff who attended, a surgeon's perspective an assessment and management of voice and helped in broadening their understanding of professional voice care. Dr. Santanu Tandon, M.S., DLO, DNB was welcomed by Dr. B S Premalatha, HOD of Speech Language Pathology.







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- 4. **International Yoga Day:** The Fourth International Yoga Day **2018** was celebrated on 21st June 2018, to commemorate the day. Across the country, many Yoga awareness programs were conducted on this day. At our Institute yoga is a regular part of the activities for students in the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) unit of the Psychology Department as well as Sunaad School. Ms. Usha conducted a session that introduced students to some of the 'aasanas' of yoga; staff and students participated enthusiastically in the event.
- 5. On August 15th, **2018 Independence Day** was celebrated with fervour by the staff and students of the Institute. As has been the practice over the years, our partners, the Lion's Club of Bangalore East took pride in participating. Dr. M.S. Venkatesh, Chairman of Bangalore Speech and Hearing Trust welcomed the gathering and gave the presidential address in which he spoke about the role of the students in upholding the growth of the nation. Lion Sukesh Reddy, President of Bangalore East Lions Club, as the Chief Guest, hoisted the National Flag. The National Anthem was followed by a speech by the Chief Guest. - 6. Women's Empowerment committee conducted an hour-long stress-breaking session titled "**This too shall pass**" on account of International Women's Day (2019) for a total of 30 teachers and clinical faculty. This session was lead by Mrs. Priya Veeraraghavan. Her session helped us understand why humans experience stress and the factors that contribute towards it. An interactive session helped listeners identify the type of stress they are going through. The staff thoroughly enjoyed the session, confident that they can find moments of laughter in stressful situations. Living in the present and going with the flow were highlighted as a key factors in the de-stressing.
 - Free Voice Camp: For the occasion of World Voice Day, the Dept. of Speech Language Studies, held a free voice screening camp for all interested from 1st to 10th April, 2019. Approximately, 20 individuals availed of this service.
 - 8. **International Yoga Day** was celebrated on the 21st of June, **2019**. Students of Sunaad School for the Hearing Impaired, students, ASD and NIOS units, and the rest of the Institute as well celebrated this day by trying out some yoga themselves. Ms. Mageetha led staff and students on this day.



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- 9. On 23rd, July 2019. A talk on "Zero Waste Cities" was given by Mrs. Padma Arun from Stonesoup Trust to the staff and students of the Institue on the occasion of World Environment Day. She emphasized on the importance of doing away with single-use plastic /other items and management of wet waste at the source. It was enlightening and motivating to those who attended
- 10. On August 15th, 2019, Independence Day was celebrated with patriotic fervour by staff and students. As has been the practice over the years, our partners, the Lion's Club of Bangalore East participated with pride along with students and staff. Dr. M.S. Treasurer, RV Trust, Bangalore was the Chief Guest on this occasion. Teachers were presented with the "Acharya Devo Bhava" award in appreciation of their service.
- 12. National Service Scheme Day: On 24th September 2019, NSS day was celebrated as "Swachh Bharath" wherein volunteers from the NSS Unit of the college, together with their support staff, cleaned the classrooms, library, and therapy rooms. The waste was disposed in an eco-friendly way. The support staff was appreciated for their dedicated hard work in keeping the institute clean.
- 13. As part of celebrations for Alternative & Augmentative Communication Awareness month, the Department of Speech-Language Studies conducted an hour-



long talk on 10th October **2019** on "Use of Alternative Augmentative Communication". **Mrs. Smrithy Rajesh** (Special Educator) delivered a beautiful and inspiring talk on My Special Journey with Advaith. She is the mother of Advaith, a child diagnosed with inadequate speech and language skills associated with ASD and ADHD". She shared her journey which included accepting a special child, enrolling him in various intervention programs, working as a co-therapist, and adapting AAC technology (AVAZ) to improve her child's communicative skills.

14. World Disability Day 2019:

On the account of World Disability Day, on 3^{rd} December 2019, the Institute offered free speech and hearing screening from 2^{nd} -7th December 2019 and a talk on "Empowering the hearing and speech impaired for the jobs in the IT sector" was delivered by **Mr.Shiva Jaygopal**, Founder and Chairman of Winvinaya Foundation. As per this year's theme, "The future is accessible", the talk focused on removing obstacles that stand in the way of the progress of people with disability especially those of people with hearing impairment in the field of IT sector.

15. Public Awareness Activities on noise awareness day:

A. On the occasion of noise awareness day, amidst the lockdown period, the Department of Hearing Studies, spread awareness on "noise and hearing health through social media".

- A. On 12th and 13th February 2020, a questionnaire-based study was conducted by BNGRC on "Awareness of the public on the effects of Noise". This was a field study; the questionnaire was responded to by the general public, attending a medical exhibition organized by NIMHANS. They were also sensitized to the effects of noise through the real-life experience of their exposure to noise levels using material developed under project "KARNA".
- B. BNGRC is working on increasing awareness of the field of speech and hearing by improving the social media presence of Dr. S.R.C.ISH and Bangalore Speech and Hearing Trust and their activities. Regular technical and non-technical updates are posted on Facebook and Linkedin. An online platform for raising crowd source funding was initiated using the online portal, 'Ketto'; funding was sought for establishing newborn hearing screening in district hospitals. This has created an awareness of the Institute's activity globally.
- **16. World Tinnitus Awareness Week** was celebrated in the 3rd week of Feb, 2021







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17. World hearing Day 2020:

- A. A week-long free hearing screening camp from 2nd March 2020 to 7th March 2020 was conducted at the institute.
- B. Awareness programs in rural and urban areas on hearing loss and the management options available were carried out. The target audience in the urban area was the general public and in the rural areas, it was the people who attended the Hearing Screening Camp. The mannequin developed by the institute, called the 'Karna' a replica of 'Jouline' created by Dangerous Decibels headed by Dr. Billy Martin measures the levels of music played by one's personal music system in the ear. This mannequin was used in the hearing screening camps to create awareness about the hazardous effect of recreational hearing.
- C. A 'Cyclothon' was organized in the heart of the city on 7th March 2020. This event was covered by local news channels, was published in local newspapers, and attracted a sizeable amount of people.
- D. A cultural program was conducted for children using cochlear implants.
- 18. Public Awareness Program 'Say Yes to Quiet' was held on 13th of November, 2020. The program was conducted for a period of 1.5hours (from 11.00 to 12.30 pm) on a virtual platform. The event was aimed at creating awareness among the public about the hazardous effects of noise and celebrating a noise-free Diwali. To create awareness about the hazardous effects of noise and celebrate noise and its sources.

19. "International Day of Persons with Disability":

A. On the occasion of 'The International Day of Persons with Disabilities on 3rd December 2020, free speech and hearing screening was conducted from 30th November to 5th December **2020**. Children sponsored by World Vision India; Bangalore were screened during this period. A total of 25 children were screened on the 3rd and 4th of December, 2020. Dr. Anita Reddy (HOD SLS, Vice principal Dr.S.R.C ISH, Ms. Prajna Kodgi (Asst. Professor) & Mr. Nitin (Clinical Supervisor) gave a talk on general speech, language, swallowing, and hearing impairments to parents and members of World Vision who were also oriented to the services available at Dr. S.R. Chandrasekhar Institute of Speech and Hearing. A Video on 'Did you know' certain facts on hearing, like causes, signs, symptoms, and treatment options available for hearing disorder was released on the **"International Day of Persons with Disability"** observed on the 3rd of December. It was planned and executed by Megha Shashidharan and HOD, department of Hearing Studies, and Ms.Surakshya Riddhi Sigdel (Masters student).





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B. A short video on "Central Auditory Processing Disorder" created using a pictorial representation of Screening Checklist for Auditory Processing (SCAP) developed by Yathiraj A. and Mascarenhas K.(2003) aimed at helping the public to reach out for help if their loved ones or children showed signs of having an auditory processing deficit. This video was released on the 3rd of December, 2020. The video was created by Ms. Tessy Henry Gomez (Assistant Professor) and Mr.Akil Dinesh (Bachelor's student).

C. Video on the success stories of children with hearing devices (Cochlear Implant and Hearing Aids and their journey from birth, identification of hearing impairment, and their path to success was beautifully portrayed by the children themselves and their parents. This video moved the hearts of many and was successful in capturing the emotion as well as the essence of what other parents of children with hearing impairment would want to hear. The video was a creative effort by Ms. Sushma Padmanabha (Clinical Supervisor) and Mr.Akhil Dinesh. This was released on 3rd December 2020 to commemorate **World Disability Day.**

D. A video aimed at creating **awareness about Speech and Language Disorders** among the general public was developed. Information on Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder, Stuttering, Cerebral Palsy, ASD, Hearing Impairment and Dyslexia were included. released by department of Speech Language Studies on 3rd December 2020 to commemorate **World Disability Day**.

E. On 19th December 2020, Live webinar in Kannada titled "From experienced parents to Novices" was conducted for the general public about hearing loss and its management.

20. World Disabilities Day:

A. A Flyer-themed "Not all Disabilities are Visible" was released on 3rd December 2020 on the occasion of **World Disabilities Day**. It displayed several hearing-related disorders and difficulties which are invisible and required professional assistance to identify.

B. A quiz on how aware the public (non-speech and hearing professionals) are of speech and hearing facts and impairments was posted on Facebook and Whatsapp, and also sent via email. Approximately 50 responses were received and the 3 participants who answered all questions correctly were declared the winners. Mrs. Neethu Sujoy (Homemaker), Bijal Morzaria (Pilot), and Nathan Athaide (non-speech and hearing





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students) will be known as "The faces of Dr.S.R.Chandrasekar Institute of Speech and Hearing" and "the most aware citizens".

- 21. **International Day of Cochlear Implant** celebrated on 25th February 2021. The program was held for the general public and titled "Your child can hear too- How a cochlear implant can help". A talk was delivered by experts in the field of audiology, auditory verbal therapy, speech therapy, and mothers training center for parents of children with hearing impairment. Free consultation was also provided on the same day.
- 22. World Hearing Day 3rd March 2021 (Images to be received and added) World Hearing Day is observed on the 3rd of March every year by the World Health Organization (WHO). On this occasion, The Department of Hearing Studies at Dr. S.R.Chandrasekhar Institute of Speech and Hearing organized several events that aimed at spreading awareness about hearing loss and promoting ear and hearing care. The activities were planned in line with the 2021 World Hearing Day theme of "Hearing Care for all: Screen, Rehabilitate and Communicate: 800 USD was received from the WHO to organize these events.
 - A. Free hearing Screening: The Department of Hearing Studies, organized a free hearing screening from the 22nd -26th of February 2021.
 - B. Human Chain: A Human Chain was organized at multiple locations across the city. Students and staff of the Institute held placards with information on hearing at these prominent locations. The locations were Kalyan Nagar on the 1st of March, MG Road on the 3rd of March & Indira Nagar on the 5th of March, 2021.
 - C. Free Hearing Aids distribution: 17 hearing aids donated by Sonova Hearing India Pvt. Ltd was distributed to deserving candidates.
 - D. Free neonatal hearing screening: it was conducted at K C General Hospital on 3rd March 2021.
 - E. Painting exhibition: "Paintaway 2021", a painting exhibition was held. Paintings of the staff and students on the World Hearing Day Theme were displayed and sold in the Institute auditorium.
 - F. Graffiti: Graffiti on the World Hearing Day theme was unveiled on the 6th of March 2021. The venue was Hennur BMTC Bus Depot.



- G. Awareness Videos: Four videos which aimed at spreading awareness about hearing loss were released. The themes of the videos are as follows: Speech and Hearing Milestones of a typically developing infant from birth to 2 years, Virtual Marathon, Video on Hearing quotes, Video of enjoying the gift of hearing.
- H. Outreach: A Mega Camp was organized at Ramakrishna Sevashrama, Pavagada on 27th March 2021. 97 individuals were screened for speech and/or hearing problems and 8 hearing aids donated by Ms. Kavitha Shetty were distributed free of cost on this occasion. Ln. V.V. Krishna Reddy, Chairman, Sri CA D.L. Suresh Babu, Secretary, Dr. Sarika Khurana, Deputy Director Clinics Ms. Prema Kumari, Camp Co-ordinator, Mr. Nitish Rajan, and other staff of the Institute attended the Megha camp.

23. Women's Day 2021:

A. A **Blood Donation** Drive was organized on 8th March 2021 by the Lion's Club of Bangalore, East to celebrate Women's Day. Students and staff donated generously.

B. On the account of Women's Day 2021, the women empowerment committee, one of the sub-committees of IQAC organized a talk via google meet on the 9th of March 2021. The talk was given by **Dr. Akkai Padmashali**, a renowned transgender social activist and motivational speaker. The talk was titled staff of "Roses and Thorns: Journey and Dream". Dr. Akkai spoke of the difficulties she faced and how she overcame them. The staff and students of Dr. S.R. Chandrasekhar Institute actively participated and benefitted from this talk.

24. World Brain Injury Awareness Day:

A. On 20th March 2021, Live on AIR Bengaluru Radio, Dr.B.S.Premalatha (Professor), was interviewed live on AIR Bengaluru Radio to spread awareness on Traumatic Brain Injury Rehabilitation.

B. On 21st March 2021, An Interview with Dr.Jacob Paul Alapatt, Neurosurgeon, MIMS Calicut, was recorded and shared on social media. This was aimed at spreading awareness of Traumatic Brain Injury to General Public.

C. On 19th March 2021 **'Helmet for Life'** to spread awareness about the effects of head injury on speech, language, swallowing and hearing. Fifty bikes with pillion riders held placards and rode from Dr.SRCISH to Cubbon Park and back; approximately 300 pamphlets were distributed to the general public along the way.

25. "Word Down Syndrome Awareness Day" on 21st March 2021. Word Down syndrome day was celebrated on 22 March with the theme #Lots of Socks since





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Chromosomes appear like socks. Colour and mismatched socks were worn to initiate a conversation about diversity, uniqueness, and inclusion.

- 26. World Voice Day 2021: The staff and students of Dr. SRCISH celebrated World Voice Day on the 16th of April with a 'Treasure Hunt'. This was based on the theme 'Voice' and took place in the institute premises.
- 27. On 15-08-2021, India's 75th **Independence Day** was celebrated with fervour at the Institute. Lion. S. Hemanth Kumar, Lion's club of Bangalore East, was the Chief Guest; Lion. V.V. Krishna Reddy, Chairman and Director of Dr. S.R.C.ISH, presided over the function. Lion. V.S. Shanthavadhan, Treasurer; Lion. Prawinkumar, Chairman, Sunaad School; and other trustees graced the occasion with their presence.
- 28. **Mental health day:** A programme for Mental Health Day was organized for parents of children with disabilities; Yoga for mental health was conducted by a parent on 11th October, 2021.
- 29. Children's Day Celebrations: On the 15th of November 2021 Children's Day was celebrated with the children of the AVT Unit along with their parents. The program started with a talk by Dr. Madhuri Gore who oriented all the parents and gave them a few tips on the use and maintenance of amplification devices. Dr. Sarika Khurana spoke about the Parents Support Network and its importance. The day was full of activities and games including fancy dress, storytelling, matching the colours, musical chairs, and dancing. At the end of the celebrations, gifts and sweets were given to all the children for their participation; prizes were distributed to all the winners of the games.
- 30. **International Cochlear Implant Day:** International Cochlear Implant Day 2022, was celebrated virtually on February 25th, 2022. In general, a lot of myths have been associated with cochlear implants as it is still a relatively uncommon procedure, especially in India. Videos focusing on busting myths about cochlear implants were released on the social handles of the Institute. The videos were released with the following hashtags and tags for better search optimization and reach *#CochlearImplant #Internationalcochlearimplantday2022 #bustmyths #spreadtheword #audiology #hearingloss #auditoryhabilitation*. The videos were made by staff members of the Dept. Hearing Studies, final year MSc Audiology, and Audiology & Speech Language Pathology (MASLP) students. Within a few hours of release, the videos had garnered hundreds of views.
- 31. **World Hearing Day** Celebration 2022: Dr. S R Chandrasekhar Institute of Speech and Hearing has been actively involved in creating awareness about Ear and Hearing



care for many years. One of the many occasions to spread awareness along with the world is on March 3rd which is celebrated as World Hearing Day by the World Health Organization. This year the theme for World Hearing Day was **"To hear for life, listen with care!"** emphasizing that loud sounds contribute to occupational as well as recreational hearing impairment. Keeping the theme in mind, activities for the week were planned and executed as follows.

A. Free Hearing Screening: The Department of Hearing Studies organized a free hearing screening from the 28^{th} of February until the 4^{th} of March with a special protocol for those in the music industry. On the 2^{nd} of March, a free hearing screening was carried out at K R Puram Police Station for Traffic police officers since they are at risk of developing hearing difficulties due to being exposed to continuous traffic noise.

B. Awareness Talk: Students at Kristu Jayanti college attended an Awareness talk on the effects of loud sounds or music on hearing and safe practices in the use of personal listening devices. This discussion with the students was led by Ms. Deena Priya and Mr. Nitin Damam (Asst. Professors, Dept. Hearing Studies) with the help of KARNA. KARNA is a mannequin developed by the institute for the purpose of measuring levels of music played by one's personal music system in the ear. This mannequin helped the students to measure the levels at which they are using their personal listening devices and thus set their devices to optimum volume settings.

C. Free Hearing aids and Ear Protective Devices: On March 3^{rd,} 2022, the Department celebrated World Hearing Day at the institute by providing free hearing aids to 10 eligible children with Hearing Impairment and 10 ear protective devices to the Assistant commissioner of traffic police. Mr. Thippeswamy, Assistant commissioner of Traffic police, was invited as the chief guest along with Disc jockey (DJ) Mr. Jasmeet Singh and journalist, Ms. Bharathi Hege as the Guests of Honour. The hearing aids and the ear protective devices were donated by Sonova India Pvt Ltd on the occasion of World Hearing Day. Mr. Avinash Grubb, Zonal Audiologist and Special Projects APAC & India from Sonova India Pvt Ltd was present at the occasion. The cultural programme by the children from the Mothers Training Centre was very impressive.

32. Women's Day 2022: To celebrate International Women's Day 2022, the **Women Empowerment Committee**, a subcommittee of IQAC (Internal Quality assurance cell) organized an event in association with IQAC on 08/03/2022. The event was in line with this year's theme: *Gender equality today for a sustainable tomorrow* with the tagline **#breakthebias.** All staff was dressed in this year's theme colors – purple, white, and green. YES ! YOUR CHILD CAN HEAR TOO- HOW A COCHLEAR IMPLANT CAN HELP?

Hearing Loss refers to a partial or complete loss of hearing in one or both ears. Because of its irreversible and progressive nature the consequences can be debilitating. According to WHO (2018) data, the prevalence of hearing impairment (HI) in India is around 6.3% (63 million people suffering from significant auditory loss). It is also alarming that four in every 1000 children suffer from severe to profound hearing loss, with over 100,000 babies being born with hearing deficiency every year. The numbers are only expected to be on the rise, however near normal hearing and speech capabilities in these children can be achieved if we act upon it. Early Identification and timely Intervention play a key role in improving the quality of life of those individuals with Hearing Impairment. A qualified Audiologist can identify Hearing Loss can within one month of age and intervention can commence immediately (inclusive of Speech and Language Therapy).

Cochlear Implant is a small yet complex device used as a popular intervention option for hearing loss in children especially in those who do not benefit from Hearing Aids. A qualified surgeon will perform the surgery which is usually associated with nil risks. The surgeon will place the electrode inside the organ of Hearing, the cochlea. After the healing time which is usually 2-3 weeks after surgery, the external component is fixed over the ears.

After activation of the device, with the combined effects of Auditory Verbal Therapy, Speech & Language Therapy and periodic device tuning (MAPping), the child can achieve near normal hearing and speech capabilities.

In India despite the advent of Cochlear Implants in the early 90's, the general public seem to be less aware and a major portion of those who are aware have accessibility issues due to financial constraints. However in today's world there are several schemes that offer financial assistance which many are oblivious of.

In an effort to curb this lack of awareness, Dr S.R. Chandrasekhar Institute of Speech and Hearing, Bengaluru observed the International Day of Cochlear Implant on 25th February by hosting a free consultation on "Does your child need a cochlear Implant" by in-house experts. The consultants were: Mr Suresh Thondatarya -Associate Professor in Speech & Hearing and Research Co-ordinator, MsRatna Shetty- Head, Mothers Training Centre , Ms KalpanaHegde- Senior Auditory Habilitationist, Mr.Shobin James- Audiologist and Assistant Professor, Ms PrajnaKodgi- Speech Language Pathologist & Assistant Professor and Ms Sushma- Auditory Habilitationist. This activity was organised by the Department of Hearing Studies in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance cell (IQAC).

Several beneficiaries actively participated and raised queries on the roadmap to successful cochlear implantation for their children. They were also briefed on the several state level and central level schemes that can aid in financial assistance for those in need. Success stories of children who have received cochlear implant were also shown to them to comfort them and

curtail their fears if any. Through this event it was possible to absolve the insecurities associated with cochlear implants in several parents and guide them towards offering their child-the gift of hearing.

Dr SR Chandrasekhar Institute of Speech and Hearing, Aided by Lions club of Bangalore East, also a unit of Bangalore Speech and Hearing Trust has a 24 years of experience in cochlear implantation under the able guidance of Dr Madhuri Gore and her enthusiastic team of Audiologists. The institute, since its inception has been actively catering to those with Hearing Impairment and providing a wide range of Speech and Hearing services to individuals of all age groups.
